Longest Ski Season in North America!

Discover [Oregon's Mt. Hood Territory](#) as you enjoy the slopes at [Timberline Ski Area](#), just 90 minutes from Portland. Timberline, the only ski area in North America open all 12 months of the year, features 3,690 vertical feet (1,125 meters) of snow-play pleasure, on the flanks of Mt. Hood, the tallest mountain in Oregon at 11,245 feet (3,427 meters). When you're done on the slopes, enjoy lunch in one of Oregon's historic treasures, Timberline Lodge. Built in the 1930s by the Works Progress Administration during the Great Depression, the Lodge is an outstanding example of Cascadian architecture; and a magnificent treasure born of desperate times. Today, the Lodge's Cascade Dining Room is known for award-winning farm-to-table cuisine. (Movie fans may recognize Timberline Lodge from Jack Nicholson's 1980 classic film, *The Shining*. But not to worry – only the exterior shots were filmed here!)
